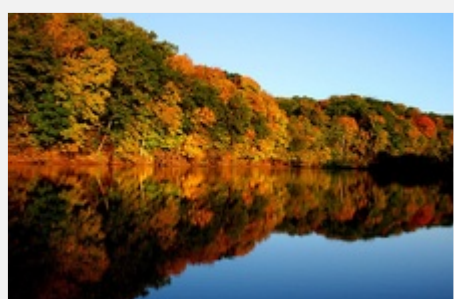

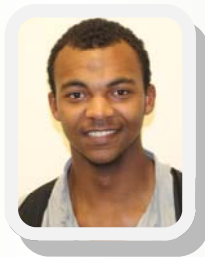
FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES
